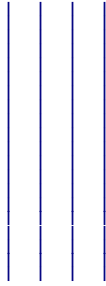

Each director will receive taped comments and a free DVD of your band's performance to help in future contest preparation.

RULES

We will follow the basic SCBDA format for our contest with the only change is that we will allow 20 minutes for each band to enter, perform and exit.

ADJUDICATION

We will follow the current SCBDA Scoring system. We will also adjudicate other captions such as Percussion, Color Guard and Drum Major.

CLASSIFICATIONS

Bands may enter either as they are classified by SCBDA or by the SCHSL or according to their Horn Line size. Out of state bands should submit their enrollment for 9-12. Any band wishing to enter for comments only may enter in Class B. Bands entering in Class B will receive a participation rating trophy.

Division 1 - Class A or up to 40 horns

Division 2 - Class AA or up to 56 horns

Division 3 - Class AAA or up to 70 Horns

Division 4 - Class 4A/5A or over 70 horns

AWARDS

Trophies will be presented to the top three bands in each division. Scores in one division cannot be compared to those in another.

Trophies will be presented to all bands earning superior and excellent ratings if they are not already in the top three in their division.

Trophies will be presented to the best drum major, best color guard, best percussion, and best horn line in each division.

FOOD, LODGING AND TRAVEL

We have numerous restaurants and motels in Walterboro. We will offer a full concession stand and can feed bands in advance.

Walterboro is located on I-95. We are 45 minutes from Charleston, 1 hour from Savannah and 90 minutes from Columbia.
